## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PRIVATE DETECTIVE AND PRIVATE GUARD IDENTIFICATION.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that within the State
- 2 some private security guards may refer to or label themselves as
- 3 police officers or law enforcement officers despite the fact
- 4 that these individuals are not public servants vested by law and
- 5 do not represent county, state, or federal law enforcement
- 6 organizations. The legislature notes that private detectives
- 7 and private guards are not permitted to imply any association
- 8 with a government agency.
- 9 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to clarify that
- 10 private detectives and private quards are prohibited from self-
- 11 identifying as a law enforcement officer, police, or police
- 12 officer.
- 13 SECTION 2. Section 463-11, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 14 amended to read as follows:
- 15 "\$463-11 Association with government not to be implied.
- 16 (a) No licensee shall use any designation or trade name which
- 17 implies any association with any municipal, county, state, or

- 1 territorial government or the federal government, or any agency
- 2 thereof; nor shall a licensee or employee of any licensee wear
- 3 or use any badge [er], uniform, equipment, vehicle, or other
- 4 accoutrement capable of being associated with the badge [ox],
- 5 uniform, equipment, vehicle, or accoutrement of any law
- 6 enforcement officer employed by a government law enforcement
- 7 organization[-]; nor shall a licensee or employee of any
- 8 licensee use the terms "law enforcement officer", "police", or
- 9 "police officer" to self-identify.
- 10 (b) Any licensee or employee of any licensee who violates
- 11 this section shall be fined not more than \$1,000, or imprisoned
- 12 not more than ninety days, or both.
- 13 (c) For purposes of this section, "law enforcement
- 14 officer" has the same meaning as in section 710-1000."
- 15 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 16 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 17 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

### Report Title:

Private Detectives; Private Guards; Law Enforcement Officers; Association with Government Agency Prohibited; Identification; Penalty

### Description:

Prohibits private detectives and private guards from selfidentifying as law enforcement officers, police, or police officers and wearing or using any badge, uniform, equipment, vehicle, or other accoutrement capable of being associated with that of a law enforcement officer employed by a government law enforcement organization. Imposes a fine for violations.
