
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO DRUGS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 712-1241, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (1) to read as follows:

3 "(1) A person commits the offense of promoting a dangerous
4 drug in the first degree if the person knowingly:

5 (a) Possesses one or more preparations, compounds,
6 mixtures, or substances of an aggregate weight of:

7 (i) One ounce or more, containing heroin, morphine,
8 or cocaine or any of their respective salts,
9 isomers, and salts of isomers; ~~[or]~~

10 (ii) One and one-half ounce or more, containing one or
11 more of any of the other dangerous drugs except
12 methamphetamine; or

13 (iii) Fifty or more capsules, tablets, ampules, dosage
14 units, or syrettes containing one or more
15 dangerous drugs;

16 (b) Distributes, except for methamphetamine:



(i) Twenty-five or more capsules, tablets, ampules, dosage units, or syrettes containing one or more dangerous drugs; or

(ii) One or more preparations, compounds, mixtures, or substances of an aggregate weight of:

(A) One-eighth ounce or more, containing heroin, morphine, or cocaine or any of their respective salts, isomers, and salts of isomers; or

(B) Three-eighths ounce or more, containing any other dangerous drug;

(c) Distributes any dangerous drug in any amount to a minor except for methamphetamine; or

(d) Manufactures a dangerous drug in any amount, except for methamphetamine; provided that this subsection shall not apply to any person registered under section 329-32."

SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were begun before its effective date.



1 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
2 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

3 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
