### A BILL FOR AN ACT

### RELATING TO ALTERNATIVE SCHOOLS FOR JUVENILES INVOLVED IN THE JUSTICE SYSTEM.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

#### PART I

2 The purpose of this part is to provide the SECTION 1. department of education funding for the sole purpose of 3 establishing and maintaining a single alternative school in the 4 leeward school district of Oahu, which shall be an off-campus 5 alternative learning center modeled after the high core program 6 in the central school district of Oahu. Applicable expenses may 7 8 include utilities, curriculum, equipment, supplies and the hiring of necessary staff. 9

10 Similar to the high core program, the alternative school in 11 the leeward school district of Oahu shall serve at-risk students 12 from all secondary schools in the district who are referred by 13 their home schools after all school level resources have been 14 utilized. The alternative school shall offer a variety of 15 programs to meet the particular needs of its students, including 16 but not limited to full-time, before-school, after-school, and

3	(1)	Ten or more unauthorized absences (current or previous

5	(2)	Academic failure in two or more courses (current or

9	(4)	One or more grade levels behind or retention (from

15	SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general			
16	revenues	of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so		
17	much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2016-2017 for a			
18	grant-in-aid to the department of education, to establish and			
19	maintain	an alternative school in the leeward school district of		
20	Oahu, to	provide ongoing education to juveniles involved in the

6 SECTION 3. The purpose of this part is to provide the 7 department of education funding for the sole purpose of 8 establishing and maintaining a single alternative school in the 9 Honolulu school district of Oahu, which shall be an off-campus 10 alternative learning center modeled after the high core program 11 in the central school district of Oahu. Applicable expenses may include utilities, curriculum, equipment, supplies and the 12 13 hiring of necessary staff.

14 Similar to the high core program, the alternative school in the Honolulu school district of Oahu shall serve at-risk 15 16 students from all secondary schools in the district who are 17 referred by their home schools after all school level resources have been utilized. The alternative school shall offer a 18 19 variety of programs to meet the particular needs of its 20 students, including but not limited to full-time, before-school, after-school, and twilight school programs. Alternative school 21



participants shall be identified by one or more of the following 1 2 criteria: Ten or more unauthorized absences (current or previous 3 (1) 4 quarter); 5 (2) Academic failure in two or more courses (current or 6 previous quarter); Three or more disciplinary referrals; Chapter 19 7 (3) disciplinary referrals for A, B, C, and D offenses; 8 One or more grade levels behind or retention (from 9 (4) kindergarten to the student's current grade level); 10 Adjudicated involvement with the juvenile justice 11 (5) 12 system (current status); or Other at-risk factors as determined by the home 13 (6) 14 school. SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general 15 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so 16 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2016-2017 for a 17 grant-in-aid to the department of education, to establish and 18 maintain an alternative school in the Honolulu school district 19 of Oahu, to provide ongoing education to juveniles involved in 20
