A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE USE OF A DOG IN JUDICIAL PROCEEDINGS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The Hawaii Revised Statutes is amended by
- 2 adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to read
- 3 as follows:
- 4 "§ Use of a facility dog. (a) For purposes of this
- 5 section:
- 6 "Facility dog" means a dog that is a graduate of an
- 7 assistance dog organization that is accredited by an
- 8 internationally recognized organization whose main purpose is to
- 9 grant accreditation to assistance dog organizations based on
- 10 standards of excellence in all areas of assistance dog
- 11 acquisition, training, and placement. A "facility dog" shall be
- 12 specially trained to provide emotional support to witnesses
- 13 testifying in judicial proceedings without causing a distraction
- 14 during the proceedings.
- "Vulnerable witness" means a witness whose ability to
- 16 testify in a judicial proceeding will be hampered or ineffective
- 17 without the assistance of a facility dog, for reasons including



- 1 but not limited to intellectual or emotional disability,
- 2 intimidation, or age.
- 3 (b) A court may permit the use of a facility dog in a
- 4 judicial proceeding involving the testimony of a vulnerable
- 5 witness if the court determines that there is a compelling
- 6 necessity for the use of a facility dog to facilitate the
- 7 testimony of the vulnerable witness.
- 8 (c) Before the use of a facility dog in a judicial
- 9 proceeding, the moving party shall file a motion certifying to
- 10 the court:
- 11 (1) The credentials of the facility dog;
- 12 (2) That the facility dog is adequately insured; and
- 13 (3) That a relationship has been established between the
- witness and the facility dog.
- 15 (d) To the extent necessary, the court may impose
- 16 restrictions, or instructions to the jury, regarding the
- 17 presence of the facility dog during the proceedings."
- 18 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on January 7, 2059.
