A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PRESCRIPTION DRUG BENEFITS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 431R, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated

 and to read as follows:

 Retail community pharmacies; outside of retail
- 5 pharmacy network; geographic exemption. (a) Notwithstanding
 6 sections 431R-2 and 431R-3, whenever the residence of a
 7 beneficiary is or more miles away from the nearest retail
- 8 community pharmacy that is part of the pharmacy benefit
- 9 manager's retail pharmacy network, the beneficiary may obtain a
- 10 prescription from any retail community pharmacy located within
- miles of the beneficiary's residence.
- (b) If a beneficiary utilizes a non-network retail
- community pharmacy pursuant to subsection (a), no prescription
- 14 drug benefit plan, health benefits plan under chapter 87A, or
- 15 pharmacy benefit manager who has entered into a contractual
- 16 retail pharmacy network agreement with a retail community
- 17 pharmacy shall:

Report Title:

Prescription Drugs Benefits; Non-network Pharmacies

Description:

Authorizes a beneficiary of a prescription drug benefit plan to obtain a prescription without penalty from a non-network retail community pharmacy located within miles of the beneficiary's residence, if the nearest network retail community pharmacy is located more than miles away. (HB1672 HD1)

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
