BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 398-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by adding a new definition to be appropriately inserted 3 and to read as follows: ""Sibling" means one of two or more individuals having at 4 5 least one parent in common whether biologically or by adoption." 6 SECTION 2. Section 398-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 7 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 8 "(a) An employee shall be entitled to a total of four 9 weeks of family leave during any calendar year upon the birth of 10 a child of the employee or the adoption of a child, or to care 11 for the employee's child, sibling, spouse or reciprocal 12 beneficiary, or parent with a serious health condition." 13 SECTION 3. Section 398-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 14 amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows: 15 "(c) When leave is to care for a child, sibling, spouse, 16 or parent who has a serious health condition, certification

shall be issued by the health care provider of the individual
