# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HOUSING.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 201H-202, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (e) to read as follows: 3 Moneys available in the fund shall be used for the "(e) 4 purpose of providing, in whole or in part, loans or grants for 5 rental housing projects in the following order of priority: 6 (1) Projects or units in projects that are allocated 7 low-income housing credits pursuant to the state 8 housing credit ceiling under section 42(h) of the 9 Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, or projects 10 or units in projects that are funded by programs of 11 the United States Department of Housing and Urban 12 Development and United States Department of 13 Agriculture Rural Development wherein: 14 (A) At least fifty per cent of the available units

(A) At least fifty per cent of the available units are for persons and families with incomes at or below [eighty] sixty per cent of the median family income of which at least [five] ten per
