## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ETHICS.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 84, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
2	by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to
3	read as follows:
4	"§84- Exemption. School employees shall be exempt from
5	compliance with sections 84-11, 84-11.5, 84-13, 84-14(a)(2), and
6	84-14 (d).
7	(b) As used in this section, "school employee" means a
8	teacher, counselor, administrator, coach, or other employee
9	employed by the department of education or a public charter
10	school who plans, organizes, or serves as a chaperone on a non-
11	publicly funded student educational trip and:
12	(1) Uses school facilities, school time, or school office
13	supplies to organize, fund raise, or promote trips; or
14	(2) Receives a travel benefit, incentive, or gift from a
15	tour or travel company that is to be used in
16	conjunction with the same educational trip on which

1	the employee serves as a chaperone, or plans or
2	organizes."
3	SECTION 2. Any existing policy, procedure, or rule
4	previously adopted by the department of education and state
5	public charter school commission shall be reviewed for
6	consistency and compliance with this Act within ninety days of
7	the effective date of this Act.
8	SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
9	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on March 15, 2037.
