- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 103D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

- 7 procedures; provided that such small purchase procurements
- 8 through an electronic system shall be required."
- 9 SECTION 4. Section 103F-405, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 10 amended to read as follows:
- "[+] \$103F-405[+] Small purchases. Purchases of health and
- 12 human services of less than [\$25,000] \$50,000 are small
- purchases, and shall be made in accordance with section 103D-305
- 14 and rules adopted by the policy board to implement that
