

### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HONOLULU AUTHORITY FOR RAPID TRANSPORTATION.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1	. (a) The auditor shall conduct a comprehensive
2	financial and	management audit of the Honolulu authority for
3	rapid transpor	tation that shall include an examination of:
4	(1) The	management and operations of the Honolulu
5	auth	ority for rapid transportation, including:
6	(A)	The Honolulu authority for rapid transportation's
7		financial plan and related systems of accounting;
8	(B)	The efficacy of the Honolulu authority for rapid
9		transportation's fiscal and management policies,
10		practices, and processes associated with the
11		plans, design, bidding, and construction of the
12		Honolulu rail transit project;
13	(C)	All contracts awarded for, and expenditures
14		associated with, the Honolulu rail transit
15		project, including payments to contractors,
16		subcontractors, and consultants; and

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1		(D)	Expenditures by the Honolulu authority for rapid
2			transportation for personnel costs, lease rent,
3			and any other costs associated with its
4			management and operations;
5	(2)	Fact	ors contributing to escalating costs associated
6		with	the Honolulu rail transit project, including:
7		(A)	Inflation;
8		(B)	Costs associated with project delays, including
9			change orders, work restrictions, and bidding
10			procedures;
11		(C)	Costs associated with legal challenges to the
12			Honolulu rail transit project, including costs of
13			change orders or delays resulting from each legal
14			challenge; and
15		(D)	Cost containment measures and any other actions
16			taken by the Honolulu authority for rapid
17			transportation to mitigate increasing costs of
18			the Honolulu rail transit project; and
19	(3)	The	total amount of county surcharge revenues
20		coll	ected pursuant to section 46-16.8, Hawaii Revised
21		Stat	utes; the amount of surcharge revenues paid to the

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1	director of finance of the city and county of				
2	Honolulu; and the amount of the surcharge revenues				
3	expended by the Honolulu authority for rapid				
4	transportation.				
5	(b) The audit shall be concluded no more than eighteen				
6	months after it begins; provided that the auditor shall submit a				
7	report of the auditor's findings and recommendations, including				
8	any proposed legislation, to the legislature no later than				
9	twenty days prior to the convening of the regular session of				
10	2018. The recommendations shall address any deficiencies				
11	identified as a result of the audit.				
12	SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general				
13	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much				
14	thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2016-2017 to conduct				
15	a comprehensive financial and management audit of the Honolulu				
16	authority for rapid transportation pursuant to section 1 of this				
17	Act.				
18	The sum appropriated shall be expended by the auditor for				
19	the purposes of this Act.				

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1 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2016.
