

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO VEHICLE NUMBER PLATES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 249-7, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "\$249-7 Number plates. (a) Upon receipt of the tax, the
- 4 director of finance shall number and register the vehicle in the
- 5 owner's name in a permanent record or book to be kept by the
- 6 director for this purpose, and shall furnish the owner thereof
- 7 with a receipt showing upon its face the license number issued
- 8 for the vehicle and the fact that the license tax has been paid
- 9 thereon for the whole or the remainder of the current year in
- 10 which the receipt is issued. The director of finance shall also
- 11 furnish the owner, upon the original registration of the
- 12 vehicle, two number plates for the vehicle or one plate in the
- 13 case of trailers, semitrailers, or motorcycles, or upon approval
- 14 of a request of the owner of a vehicle pursuant to subsection
- 15 (f), with the registration number marked thereon. Upon the
- 16 payment of the tax for each year, a tag or emblem bearing a
- 17 serial number and the month and year of expiration shall be



- 1 provided to the owner. Transfer of current number plates, tag,
- 2 or emblem, except as authorized by this chapter or by chapter
- 3 286, is punishable by a fine of not more than \$50 for each
- 4 offense.
- 5 (b) Upon an original registration the director of finance
- 6 shall fix, and shall charge to the owner, a fee equal to the
- 7 cost of the number plate and tag or emblem plus the
- 8 administrative cost of furnishing the plate and tag or emblem
- 9 and effecting the registration. Upon the issuance of a new
- 10 series of number plates as determined by the directors of
- 11 finance of each county through majority consent, the director of
- 12 finance shall charge the owner a fee equal to the costs of the
- 13 number plate plus the administrative cost of furnishing the
- 14 plates. Upon issuing a tag or emblem, the director of finance
- 15 shall charge the owner a fee of 50 cents. The owner shall
- 16 securely fasten the number plates on the vehicle, one on the
- 17 front and the other on the rear, at a location provided by the
- 18 manufacturer or in the absence of such a location upon the
- 19 bumpers of the vehicle and in conformance with section 291-31,
- 20 in such a manner as to prevent the plates from swinging [-];
- 21 provided that if the owner of any vehicle has received one



- 1 number plate upon original registration of the vehicle or
- 2 returns one number plate to the director of finance pursuant to
- 3 subsection (f), the owner shall not be required to fasten a
- 4 number plate to the front of the vehicle. Number plates shall
- 5 at all times be displayed entirely unobscured and be kept
- 6 reasonably clean. In the case of trailers, semitrailers, or
- 7 motorcycles, one plate shall be used and it shall be fastened to
- 8 the rear thereof at a location provided by the manufacturer or
- 9 in the absence of such a location at the rear thereof, and in
- 10 the case of motorcycles in conformance with section 291-31.
- 11 (c) Upon the issuance of the tag or emblem the owner shall
- 12 affix the tag or emblem to the top right portion of the rear
- 13 number plate, except that all vehicles owned by the State, any
- 14 county government, any board of water supply, and official
- 15 representatives of any foreign governments shall be issued
- 16 registrations which need be renewed only in the new plate issue
- 17 year.
- 18 (d) After the initial payment of the tax and the original
- 19 registration of a vehicle as herein specified, a motor vehicle
- 20 shall not be required to be reweighed in any succeeding year
- 21 unless it has been so altered or changed as to increase or

- 1 diminish its weight. No new number plates shall, however, be
- 2 issued to a new owner except as provided in sections 249-7.5 and
- 3 249-8.
- 4 (e) If an owner of a vehicle registered in any county,
- 5 upon the disposition of the vehicle, requests that the license
- 6 plates furnished to the owner with respect to the registration
- 7 of the vehicle be assigned to another vehicle subsequently
- 8 acquired by the owner, the assignment may be made by the
- 9 director of finance at the director's discretion. To defray
- 10 additional administrative costs incurred by acceding to those
- 11 requests, the director of finance shall charge a fee of \$5 for
- 12 each reassignment of license plates, in addition to the fee for
- 13 registration. The procedure for registering the vehicles shall
- 14 otherwise be identical with that provided by this section.
- 15 (f) The director of finance shall allow the owner of any
- 16 vehicle containing safety equipment originally installed by the
- 17 vehicle manufacturer that would be or is impaired by a front
- 18 number plate to:
- 19 (1) Request one number plate upon original registration of
- the vehicle; or

1	(2) Remove and return the front number plate of a vehicle
2	that has been registered.
3	The director of finance shall adopt rules pursuant to
4	chapter 91 specifying the vehicles with safety equipment
5	originally installed by the vehicle manufacturer that are
6	impaired by a front number plate."
7	SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
8	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
9	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
