5	pharmacy may provide a customized patient medication package to	
6	any patient of an institutional facility or any member of the	
7	general public; provided that:	
8	(1)	The pharmacy has obtained the consent of the patient,
9		patient's caregiver, patient's guardian, or
10		prescribing practitioner;
11	(2)	The consent is accompanied with the patient's current
12		prescription; and
13	(3)	The customized patient medication package meets the
14		requirements of section 328-16.
15	<u>(b)</u>	As used in this section:
16	"Cus	tomized patient medication package" means a package
17	that is prepared by a pharmacist for a specific patient and	
18	contains one or more prescribed solid oral dosage forms.
