A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HOMELESSNESS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that Hawaii has the
- 2 highest per capita rate of homelessness of any state in the
- 3 nation. Hawaii also has the highest rate of chronic unsheltered
- 4 homeless per capita of any state. Currently, an estimated 7,620
- 5 people are living on the streets and in shelters in Hawaii.
- 6 Addressing homelessness requires a multi-faceted approach using
- 7 interventions targeted to the particular characteristics of the
- 8 population being served.
- 9 The legislature further finds that outreach is a critical
- 10 piece of the coordinated entry system. The legislature finds
- 11 that more strategic, coordinated outreach is needed to
- 12 assertively serve the growing percentage of homeless persons who
- 13 are not living in shelter programs. As the counties and the
- 14 State increase enforcement efforts in parks and public areas,
- 15 outreach to homeless persons becomes even more significant.
- 16 State efforts for outreach have focused on individual adults and
- 17 families with children.

- 1 The legislature also finds that unaccompanied homeless
- 2 youth are often hard to locate and identify and are particularly
- 3 vulnerable to exploitation. Between 2000 and 2010, over thirty
- 4 per cent of all juvenile arrests in Hawaii were for running away
- 5 from home. Outreach is especially critical to help newly
- 6 homeless youth navigate the social services system to find safe
- 7 alternatives to homelessness. Youth service providers report
- 8 that the number of homeless youth has been increasing each year.
- 9 The legislature further finds that the State needs to address
- 10 youth homelessness to prevent these homeless youth from becoming
- 11 homeless adults.
- 12 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds to the
- 13 department of human services, including the office of youth
- 14 services, to provide additional outreach services.
- 15 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 16 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 17 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2016-2017 for
- 18 additional outreach to homeless individuals and families with
- 19 children.
- The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 21 human services for the purposes of this Act.

- 1 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 3 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2016-2017 for
- 4 outreach to unaccompanied homeless youth.
- 5 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the office of
- 6 youth services of the department of human services for the
- 7 purposes of this Act.
- 8 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
