10	(b) Nothing in subsection (a) shall be interpreted to

Actions against an association, a board of directors,
 or one or more directors, officers, agents, employees,
 or other persons for amounts in excess of \$2,500 if
 insurance coverage under a policy of insurance
 procured by the association or its board of directors
 would be unavailable for defense or judgment because

8 (C) If any mediation under this section is not completed 9 within two months from commencement, no further mediation shall 10 be required unless agreed to by the association and the member. 11 In the event mediation does not resolve the dispute, (d) 12 at the request of any party, the office of the ombudsman shall 13 be assigned to settle the dispute with the initiating party 14 paying the initial fees necessary to settle such dispute;

15 provided that the final liability for the fees shall be

16 determined by the office of the ombudsman."
