

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The department of education shall submit a 2 report to the legislature no later than twenty days prior to the 3 convening of the regular session of 2018 on:
- 4 (1) The department's progress toward implementing sections
 5 302A-1141, 302A-1141.3 and 302A-1141.4, Hawaii Revised
 6 Statutes; and
- 7 (2) The expenditure of the funds appropriated in section
 8 2, including details of the training provided and the
 9 data accountability to assist with implementation of
 10 sections 302A-1141, 302A-1141.3 and 302A-1141.4,
 11 Hawaii Revised Statutes.
- SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$460,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2016-2017 to fund one full-time equivalent position (1.0 FTE) to provide training and data accountability to assist with the effective

- 3 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 4 education for the purposes of this Act.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2016.
