# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LOBBYING EXPENDITURES.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 97-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending the definition of "expenditure" to read as 3 follows: "Expenditure" includes a payment, distribution, 4 "(4) 5 forgiveness of a loan, advance, deposit, or gift of 6 money, or anything of value and includes a contract, 7 promise, or agreement, whether or not enforceable, to make an expenditure. "Expenditure" also includes 9 compensation or other consideration paid to a lobbyist **10** for the performance of lobbying services. 11 ["Expenditure" excludes the expenses of preparing 12 written testimony and exhibits for a hearing before 13 the legislature or an administrative agency.] " 14 Section 97-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is SECTION 2. 15 amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows: 16 "(c) The statement shall contain the following **17** information:

1	(1)	The name and address of each person with respect to
2		whom expenditures for the purpose of lobbying in the
3		total sum of \$25 or more per day was made by the
4		person filing the statement during the statement
5		period and the amount or value of [such] the
6		expenditure;
7	(2)	The name and address of each person with respect to
8		whom expenditures for the purpose of lobbying in the
9		aggregate of \$150 or more was made by the person
10		filing the statement during the statement period and
11		the amount or value of [such] the expenditures;
12	(3)	The total sum or value of all expenditures for the
13		purpose of lobbying made by the person filing the
14		statement during the statement period [in excess of
15		\$750 during the statement period]; provided that the
16		sum or value of each expenditure is itemized in the
17		following categories, as applicable:
18		(A) Preparation and distribution of lobbying
19		materials;
20		(B) Media advertising;
21		(C) Compensation paid to lobbyists;

1		(D) Fees paid to consultants or services;	
2		(E) Entertainment and events;	
3		(F) Receptions, meals, food, and beverages;	
4		(G) Gifts;	
5		(H) Loans; and	
6		(I) Other disbursements;	
7	(4)	The name and address of each person making	
8		contributions to the person filing the statement for	
9		the purpose of lobbying in the total sum of \$25 or	
10		more during the statement period and the amount or	
11		value of [such] the contributions; and	
12	(5)	The subject area of the legislative and administrative	
13		action which was supported or opposed by the person	
14		filing the statement during the statement period."	
15	SECT	ION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that	
16	matured,	penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were	
17	begun before its effective date.		
18	SECT	ION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed	
19	and stric	ken. New statutory material is underscored.	
20	SECT	ION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2030.	

## Report Title:

Ethics Commission Package; Lobbyists; Expenditures

### Description:

Broadens the term "expenditures" by removing the exemption for expenses relating to the preparation of testimony before a legislative or administrative hearing. Requires a lobbyist's statement of expenditures to include total expenditures, rather than expenditures over \$750. (HB181 HD1)
