A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO RESPIRATORY THERAPISTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that chapter 466D, Hawaii
Revised Statutes, establishes the regulation of respiratory
therapists, which is set to repeal on June 30, 2016.
Furthermore, pursuant to chapter 26H, Hawaii Revised Statutes,
the auditor is required to evaluate newly enacted occupational
regulatory programs prior to each board's, commission's, or
regulatory program's repeal date.


8 The legislature further finds that an auditor's report from 9 June 2015 finds that the regulation of respiratory therapists is 10 reasonably necessary to protect the health and safety of 11 consumers. The findings also note that licensure of respiratory 12 therapists is consistent with other health-related occupations, such as doctors and nurses, and is warranted because consumers' 13 14 health and safety may be jeopardized by the nature of services 15 offered by respiratory therapists. Furthermore, every state except Alaska regulates respiratory therapists. 16

Section 26H-4, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 5 6 amended to read as follows: "§26H-4 Repeal dates for newly enacted professional and 7 vocational regulatory programs. (a) Any professional or 8 vocational regulatory program enacted after January 1, 1994, and 9 10 listed in this section shall be repealed as specified in this section. The auditor shall perform an evaluation of the 11 program, pursuant to section 26H-5, prior to its repeal date. 12 13 [(b) Chapter 466D (respiratory therapists) shall be repealed on June 30, 2016. 14 (c)] (b) Chapter 436H (athletic trainers) shall be 15 repealed on June 30, 2018." 16 SECTION 3.
