## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 84-14, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is	
2	amended by	y amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
3	"(a)	No employee shall take any official action directly
4	affecting:	
5	(1)	A business or other undertaking in which the employee
6		has a substantial financial interest; [or]
7	(2)	A private undertaking in which the employee is engaged
8		as legal counsel, advisor, consultant, representative,
9		or other agency capacity[+]; or
10	<u>(3)</u>	A business or other undertaking in which the employee
11		knows or has reason to know that a parent, sibling, or
12		emancipated child of the employee has a substantial
13		financial interest; provided that the financial
14		interests of the individual shall not include the
15		interests of a spouse or child.
16	A department head who is unable to disqualify the	
17	department	t head's self on any matter described in paragraphs (1)

- 1 [and], (2), and (3) will not be in violation of this subsection
- 2 if the department head has complied with the disclosure
- 3 requirements of section 84-17.
- 4 A person whose position on a board, commission, or
- 5 committee is mandated by statute, resolution, or executive order
- 6 to have particular qualifications shall only be prohibited from
- 7 taking official action that directly and specifically affects a
- 8 business or undertaking in which the person has a substantial
- 9 financial interest; provided that the substantial financial
- 10 interest is related to the member's particular qualifications."
- 11 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 12 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 13 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2030.
