# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE DISPOSITION OF THE CONVEYANCE TAX COLLECTIONS TO THE RENTAL HOUSING REVOLVING FUND.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 247-7, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows: 3 "§247-7 Disposition of taxes. All taxes collected under 4 this chapter shall be paid into the state treasury to the credit 5 of the general fund of the State, to be used and expended for 6 the purposes for which the general fund was created and exists 7 by law; provided that of the taxes collected each fiscal year: 8 (1) Ten per cent or \$6,800,000, whichever is less, shall 9 be paid into the land conservation fund established 10 pursuant to section 173A-5; and 11 (2) Fifty per cent [or \$38,000,000, whichever is less,] 12 shall be paid into the rental housing revolving fund 13 established by section 201H-202." 14 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 15 and stricken. 16 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
