9	(b)	Subsection (a) shall not apply to:
10	(1)	Contracts executed pursuant to chapter 103, 103D,
11		103F, 104, or any other contract for services for
12		which a contracting process is established by law;
13	(2)	The respective counties;
14	(3)	The legislative branch of state government;
15	(4)	Seasonal hires by the department of taxation; or

1	(5) Bona fide employees held over after retirement for
2	training purposes with a training plan that is filed
3	with the department of human resources development."
4	SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
5	matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
6	begun before its effective date.
7	SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
8	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2017.
