(a) No 5 department or agency of the State shall temporarily employ the same person in the same position for more than two terms of 6 7 eighty-nine days; provided that with the approval of the governor, a department or agency of the State may temporarily 8 9 employ the same person in the same position for eight terms of 10 eighty-nine days within a consecutive twenty-four-month period. 11 (b) This section shall not apply to periods of temporary employment when a person has been appointed to a vacant position 12 13 arising as a result of: 14 (1) A workers' compensation claim; 15 (2) Medical leave; 16 (3) An on-going investigation; 17 (4) A shortage category;
