## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC EMPLOYMENT.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 76, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
  by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to
  read as follows:

  "§76- Temporary employment; prohibitions; abolishing of
  positions. (a) No department shall temporarily employ any
  person for more than two consecutive terms of eighty-nine days;
  provided that with the approval of the governor, a department
- 8 may temporarily employ a person for four consecutive terms of
- 9 eighty-nine days or for twenty-four consecutive months.
- 10 (b) Any position filled by a temporary employee hired for
- 11 a term of eighty-nine days and filled by that employee for more
- 12 than twenty-four consecutive months shall be automatically
- 13 abolished.
- 14 (c) This section shall not apply to periods of temporary
- 15 employment when a person has been appointed to a vacant position
- 16 arising as a result of: a workers' compensation claim; medical
- 17 leave; an on-going investigation; a shortage differential; a

- 1 working condition differential; or a remote geographical
- 2 location."
- 3 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2016.
