A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HOISTING MACHINE OPERATORS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 396-19, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows: [The hoisting machine operators advisory board may 3 "(b) employ a 0.5 full time equivalent executive director, without 4 5 regard to chapters 76 and 89 and may dismiss such person as it finds necessary for the performance of its function and duties. 6 7 The board shall have the authority to fix the executive 8 director's compensation.] The department shall provide the 9 hoisting machine operators advisory board administrative support staff to assist the board in fulfilling its function. The board 10 may establish fees to be charged for any aspect relating to the 11 issuance of permits or certificates pursuant to chapter 91." 12 SECTION 2. Section 396-20, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 13 14 repealed. ["[\$396-20] Hoisting machine operators' certification 15 revolving fund. (a) There is established in the state treasury 16
