### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MILITARY LAND.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 121-10, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "§121-10 Administration. The adjutant general shall from
- 4 time to time make and publish such orders and regulations, not
- 5 inconsistent with law, as are necessary to bring the
- 6 organization, armament, equipment, and discipline of the
- 7 organized militia to a state of efficiency as nearly as possible
- 8 approaching that of the army and air force of the United States.
- 9 The adjutant general shall attest all commissions issued to
- 10 military officers, appointments issued to warrant officers,
- 11 maintain personnel records, superintend preparation of all
- 12 letters and reports required by the United States from the
- 13 State. The adjutant general shall have charge of the state
- 14 military reservations, armories, and all other property of the
- 15 State kept or used for military purposes. The adjutant general
- 16 shall have charge of all property of the State leased to the
- 17 United States Army. The adjutant general shall take an

- 1 inventory at least once each year of all military stores,
- 2 property, and funds under the adjutant general's jurisdiction.
- 3 The adjutant general shall be the official custodian of the
- 4 military records of all persons from the State who served in the
- 5 armed forces of the United States during times of war or grave
- 6 national emergency, including those records [which-are] turned
- 7 over to the State by the federal agency of selective service.
- 8 The records shall be preserved perpetually in accordance with
- 9 rules and regulations established by the adjutant general.
- 10 The adjutant general shall make an annual report of the
- 11 operations of the adjutant general's department."
- 12 SECTION 2. Without regard to chapter 171, Hawaii Revised
- 13 Statutes, by June 30, 2017, each department shall convey to the
- 14 state department of defense all state lands that are under the
- 15 control of that department and that are leased by the United
- 16 States Army.
- 17 SECTION 3. The department of defense shall submit to the
- 18 legislature, no later than twenty days prior to the convening of
- 19 the regular sessions of 2017 and 2018, a report that documents:
- 20 (1) All state lands leased by the United States Army; and

- SECTION 4. All appropriations, records, equipment, 3
- machines, files, supplies, contracts, books, papers, documents, 4
- maps, and other personal property heretofore made, used, 5
- acquired, or held by any agency or department relating to the 6
- functions transferred to the department of defense shall be 7
- 8 transferred with the functions to which they relate.
- 9 SECTION 5. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. **10**
- SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect upon its approval. 11
