# A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH TO REESTABLISH A VECTOR CONTROL BRANCH.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. This Act is recommended by the governor for
- 2 immediate passage in accordance with article VII, section 9, of
- 3 the Constitution of the State of Hawaii.
- 4 SECTION 2. In accordance with article VII, section 9, of
- 5 the Constitution of the State of Hawaii and sections 37-91 and
- 6 37-93, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the legislature has determined
- 7 that appropriations contained in section 4 of this Act will
- 8 cause the state general fund expenditure ceiling for fiscal year
- $\mathbf{9}$  2015-2016 to be exceeded by  $\mathbf{\$}$  , or per cent. The
- 10 reasons for exceeding the general fund expenditure ceiling are
- 11 that the appropriations made in this Act are necessary to serve
- 12 the public interest and to meet the needs addressed by this Act.
- 13 SECTION 3. The legislature finds that vector control
- 14 involves controlling the spread of animals that have the
- 15 potential to carry disease, from rodents to insects, including
- 16 mosquitoes. However, the Hawaii department of health currently

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- 1 lacks sufficient staffing and resources due to funding cuts
- 2 suffered during the recession of several years ago.
- 3 According to a June 17, 2015, news story on KHON2,
- 4 department of health officials plan to hire more workers for its
- 5 vector control unit, but the department still will not have
- 6 nearly as many workers as it once did.
- 7 The legislature further finds that the current outbreak of
- 8 dengue fever necessitates an appropriation to the department of
- 9 health to hire more vector control employees and reestablish a
- 10 vector control branch.
- 11 Thus, the purpose of this Act is to:
- 12 (1) Provide an emergency appropriation for the department
- of health to target additional resources for the
- 14 county of Hawaii to support ongoing activities in
- addressing the dengue fever outbreak; and
- 16 (2) Appropriate additional positions and funds within the
- 17 department of health to reestablish sufficient vector
- 18 control branch resources to address potential
- 19 statewide epidemiological events.
- 20 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general
- 21 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$500,000 or so much

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- 1 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2015-2016 for the
- 2 department of health to target additional resources for the
- 3 county of Hawaii to support ongoing activities in addressing the
- 4 dengue fever outbreak, including the hiring of necessary staff.
- 5 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 6 health for the purposes of this Act.
- 7 SECTION 5. There is appropriated out of the general
- 8 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 9 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2016-2017 for the
- 10 department of health to hire full-time equivalent positions
- 11 for vector control, including a vector control program manager
- 12 and staff positions, and to take steps to fully reestablish a
- 13 vector control branch within the department of health
- 14 environmental health administration.
- 15 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 16 health for the purposes of this Act.
- 17 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect upon its approval,
- 18 provided that section 5 shall take effect on July 1, 2016.
