PROPOSING AMENDMENTS TO THE CONSTITUTION OF THE STATE OF HAWAII TO AUTHORIZE THE BOARD OF EDUCATION TO IMPOSE A SURCHARGE ON REAL PROPERTY TAXES TO FUND PUBLIC SCHOOL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to propose amendments to the Hawaii Constitution to authorize the board of 2 3 education to impose a surcharge on real property taxes to fund public school capital improvement projects. 4 SECTION 2. Article VIII, section 3, of the Constitution of 5 the State of Hawaii is amended to read as follows: 6 7 "Section 3. The taxing power shall be reserved to the State, except so much thereof as may be delegated by the 8 legislature to the political subdivisions, and except that all 9 functions, powers and duties relating to the taxation of real 10 property shall be exercised exclusively by the counties, with 11 12 the exception of the county of Kalawao [-]; provided that the board of education shall not be prohibited from imposing a 13 14 surcharge on real property taxes pursuant to Section 3 of

1	Article X. The legislature shall have the power to apportion
2	state revenues among the several political subdivisions."
3	SECTION 3. Article X, section 3, of the Constitution of
4	the State of Hawaii is amended to read as follows:
5	"Section 3. The board of education shall have the power,
6	as provided by law, to [formulate]:
7	(1) Formulate statewide educational policy and appoint the
8	superintendent of education as the chief executive
9	officer of the public school system $[-]$; and
10	(2) Impose a surcharge on real property taxes to fund
11	public school capital improvement projects."
12	SECTION 4. The question to be printed on the ballot shall
13	be as follows:
14	"Shall the board of education be authorized to impose a
15	surcharge on real property taxes to fund public school
16	capital improvement projects?"
17	SECTION 5. Constitutional material to be repealed is
18	bracketed and stricken. New constitutional material is
