The board of 4 5 regents shall waive the tuition of any person who enrolls as a 6 student in a community college under the following conditions: 7 The person is a United States citizen or an eligible (1) non-citizen, as determined by the board; 8 9 The person has been a resident of the State for at (2) 10 least twelve months prior to the time of applying for 11 the waiver; 12 (3) The person is a graduate of a private or public high 13 school located in the State; 14 (4)The person is admitted to and enrolled full-time in a community college; 15
