A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE RENTAL HOUSING REVOLVING FUND.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the development and
- 2 rehabilitation of rental housing in the State is a priority and
- 3 must be addressed to provide for future generations. Funding
- 4 must be available to provide housing to keep families intact and
- 5 children off the streets.
- 6 The legislature further finds that the rental housing
- 7 revolving fund provides funding for rental housing units, but is
- 8 currently capped at \$38,000,000. This amount is not sufficient
- 9 to provide the funding needed to address the State's current
- 10 housing crisis.
- 11 The purpose of this Act is to amend the cap on moneys
- 12 deposited into the rental housing revolving fund to allow up to
- 13 \$100,000,000 to be paid into the fund, to support the
- 14 development and rehabilitation of more rental housing units in
- 15 the State.
- 16 SECTION 2. Section 247-7, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 17 amended to read as follows:

1	"§247-7 Disposition of taxes. All taxes collected under
2	this chapter shall be paid into the state treasury to the credit
3	of the general fund of the State, to be used and expended for
4	the purposes for which the general fund was created and exists
5	by law; provided that of the taxes collected each fiscal year:
6	(1) Ten per cent or \$6,800,000, whichever is less, shall
7	be paid into the land conservation fund established
8	pursuant to section 173A-5; and
9	(2) Fifty per cent or [\$38,000,000,] \$100,000,000,
10	whichever is less, shall be paid into the rental
11	housing revolving fund established by section 201H-
12	202."
13	SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
14	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
15	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2016.
