BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 431, article 10C, Hawaii Revised
- 2 Statutes, is amended by adding a new section to part III to be
- 3 appropriately designated and to read as follows:
- 4 "§431:10C- Prompt payment of uninsured and underinsured
- 5 motorist claims. In a claim that is accepted for coverage under
- 6 uninsured motorist coverage or underinsured motorist coverage,
- 7 the insurer shall pay to the claimant an amount the insurer
- 8 deems reasonable, if any, within thirty days of a demand for
- 9 payment of the claim. If after the payment, the value of the
- 10 claim is still in dispute between the insurer and the claimant,
- 11 the matter may be resolved according to the provisions in the
- 12 motor vehicle insurance policy; provided that any undisputed
- 13 amount that is paid to the claimant shall be disclosed to the
- 14 arbitrator or judge at the commencement of any litigation, and
- 15 the amount paid shall be deducted from the amount of any
- 16 judgment or award. This section shall not affect any recourse
- 17 the claimant may have against the insurer."

Report Title:

Uninsured Motorist; Underinsured Motorist; Prompt Claims Payment

Description:

Requires an insurer in a claim under uninsured or underinsured motorist coverage to pay to the claimant an amount the insurer deems reasonable within thirty days of a demand for payment of the claim. Requires any undisputed amount paid to a claimant to be disclosed to the arbitrator or judge and deducted from the amount of any judgment or award.

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
