A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 The legislature finds that the payment of SECTION 1. 2 student athletic fees at the tertiary-education level should be 3 voluntary, not mandatory. Many colleges and universities throughout the nation avail themselves of a variety of financial 4 5 resources beyond their campuses to fund their athletic programs 6 and do not place such financial burdens on their students, many 7 of whom are not interested in participating in or attending any 8 form of athletic competition. 9 On July 15, 2010, the board of regents of the University of 10 Hawaii approved a student athletic fee of \$50 per semester that 11 became effective in spring 2011 for students at the University 12 of Hawaii at Manoa. There is currently a proposal before the board of regents to double the student athletic fee to \$100 per 13 14 semester as a means to help pay for the athletic department's 15 anticipated financial shortfall in 2016. However, institutions 16 of higher education exist to educate their students, and **17** athletic programs should cover their own costs.

- 4 The purpose of this Act is to prohibit the University of
- 5 Hawaii board of regents from charging student athletic fees.
- 6 SECTION 2. Section 304A-401, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 7 amended to read as follows:
- 8 "[+]§304A-401[+] Tuition fees; resident, nonresident;
- 9 other fees. (a) The board of regents may charge resident and
- 10 nonresident tuition fees for regular courses of instruction at
- 11 any University of Hawaii campus, including any community
- 12 college.
- 13 (b) The board may also charge other fees for special
- 14 programs of instruction, as well as laboratory fees, course
- 15 fees, fees for student activities, and an information technology
- 16 user fee. The board may charge other fees for summer session or
- 17 evening courses, including differential fees for nonresident
- 18 students.
- 19 (c) Notwithstanding subsection (b) to the contrary, the
- 20 board shall not charge student athletic fees."

- 3 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2016.
