BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 291-71, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows: 3 "§291-71 Designation of parking spaces for electric 4 vehicles; charging system[.]; penalty. (a) [Places of public

accommodation] Parking facilities with at least one hundred parking spaces available for use by the general public shall 6

7 have at least one parking space exclusively for electric

8 vehicles and equipped with an electric vehicle charging system

9 located anywhere in the parking structure or lot by January 1,

2017; provided that no parking space designated for electric

vehicles shall displace or reduce accessible stalls required by

12 the Americans with Disabilities Act Accessibility Guidelines.

13 Spaces shall be designated, clearly marked, and the exclusive

designation enforced. Owners of multiple parking facilities

15 within the State may designate and electrify fewer parking

16 spaces than required in one or more of their owned properties;

- 1 provided that the scheduled requirement is met for the total
- 2 number of aggregate spaces on all of their owned properties.
- 3 (b) Police officers shall issue a citation to the owner of
- 4 a parking facility that fails to comply with this section.
- 5 (c) Beginning January 1, 2017, an owner of a parking
- 6 facility that fails to comply with this section shall be fined:
- 7 (1) \$1,000 for the first violation;
- **8** (2) \$5,000 for the second violation;
- 9 (3) \$10,000 for the third violation; and
- 10 (4) \$20,000 for the fourth violation and any subsequent
- violations thereafter;
- 12 provided that the owner shall be allowed one hundred twenty days
- 13 after any violation to comply with this section without being
- 14 cited for another violation.
- 15 [(b)] (d) For the purposes of this section:
- "Electric vehicle" means:
- 17 (1) A neighborhood electric vehicle as defined in section
- 18 286-2; or
- 19 (2) A vehicle, with four or more wheels, that draws
- 20 propulsion energy from a battery with at least four

1		kilowatt hours of energy storage capacity that can be
2		recharged from an external source of electricity.
3	"Ele	ctric vehicle charging system" means a system that:
4	(1)	Is capable of providing electricity from a non-vehicle
5		source to charge the batteries of one or more electric
6		vehicles;
7	(2)	Meets recognized standards, including standard SAE
8		J1772 of SAE International; and
9	(3)	Is designed and installed in compliance with article
10		625 of the National Electrical Code.
11	["b]	ace of public accommodation" has the same meaning as

13	<u>"Par</u>	king facility" means a parking lot, parking structure,
14	parking g	arage, or other facility offering parking in connection
15	with:

19		provides lodging to transient guests;
20	(3)	A shopping center, shopping mall, or any establishment
