## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TECHNOLOGY IN SCHOOLS.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be designated and to read as
3	follows:
4	" <u>§302A-</u> <u>Curricular materials; digital format.</u> <u>Moneys</u>
5	allocated for printed curricular materials may be expended to
6	purchase digital formats of the curricular materials."
7	SECTION 2. Section 302A-101, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
8	amended as follows:
9	1. By adding a new definition to be appropriately inserted
10	and to read:
11	" <u>"Curricular materials</u> " means any systematically organized
12	material designed to provide a specific level of instruction in
13	a subject-matter category, including textbooks, instructional
14	materials, library books, equipment, computer software, digital
15	content accessed through a computer or other electronic medium,
16	digital content available through an internet-based provider of

1 course content, or supplies used in a particular course of 2 study." 3 2. By repealing the definition of "school textbooks, 4 instructional materials, library books, equipment, or supplies". [""School-textbooks, instructional materials, library 5 6 books, equipment, or supplies" includes any book, printed 7 matter, or other material used in a particular course of 8 study."] 9 SECTION 3. Section 302A-1130.6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, 10 is amended to read as follows: 11 "§302A-1130.6 [<del>Textbook and instructional</del>] Curricular 12 materials fee special account. There is established within the 13 department a [textbook-and instructional] curricular materials 14 fee special account, into which shall be deposited all fees and 15 charges collected from students or their parents or guardians 16 for the loss, destruction, breakage, or damage of [school 17 textbooks, instructional materials, library books, equipment, or supplies.] curricular materials. Disbursements from this 18 special account shall be expended by the department for the 19 purposes of purchasing, replacing, or repairing [school 20

3	SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general
4	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much

8	The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
9	education for the purposes of this Act.
10	SECTION 5. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
11	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
12	SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
