#### JUSTIFICATION SHEET

- DEPARTMENT: Business, Economic Development, and Tourism
- TITLE: A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE HAWAII GREEN INFRASTRUCTURE AUTHORITY.
- PURPOSE: Change the size and composition of the Hawaii Green Infrastructure Authority (HGIA) from five to seven members.
- MEANS: Amend section 196-63, Hawaii Revised Statutes.
- JUSTIFICATION: The increase of size of the authority allows for better public representation on the HGIA. As it currently stands, three of the five members are ex-officio members of state government and hold the majority.
