## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AGE OF CONSENT FOR ADOLESCENT MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 577, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated 3 and to read as follows: 4 "§577- Mental health services relating to minors; 5 diagnosis, counseling, and related activities. (a) 6 Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, a minor who is 7 fourteen years of age or older may consent to mental health 8 treatment or counseling services provided by a licensed mental 9 health professional if, in the opinion of the licensed mental 10 health professional, the minor is mature enough to participate
- (b) The mental health treatment or counseling services of

- 14 or counseling services pursuant to this section, the minor shall

- (e) The minor's parents or guardian shall not be liable

- 18 provided pursuant to this section unless the parent or quardian

Authorizes a minor who is fourteen years of age or older to consent to mental health treatment or counseling services by a licensed mental health professional if the professional deems the minor is mature enough to participate intelligently in the treatment or services. (HB2357 HD1)
