### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TRANSFERABILITY OF MOORING PERMITS.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 200-10, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by amending subsection (d) to read as follows:
3	$^{ullet}$ (d) The department shall not renew or issue a permit to a
4	person who is not the owner of the vessel which is moored or
5	which the person desires to moor in a state small boat harbor.
6	No use permit may be transferred unless specifically provided by
7	law.
8	Any person possessing a mooring permit shall be allowed to
9	transfer the mooring permit to the new vessel owner upon sale of
10	the vessel by satisfaction of the following conditions:
11	(1) The sale price of the vessel shall be established by
12	appraisal from a state licensed surveyor, provided
13	that the vessel shall not be sold for more than the
14	appraised value and the terms of the sale shall be set
15	at fair market value; and
16	(2) The seller shall pay to the department a transfer fee
17	of \$100 per foot of vessel length overall upon

1	approval of the mooring permit transfer to the new
2	vessel owner.
3	Any individual who is an owner of a vessel used for
4	commercial purposes, including commercial fishing as a principal
5	means of livelihood, and possesses a valid mooring permit or
6	commercial permit, or both, in accordance with the rules adopted
7	by the chairperson pursuant to chapter 91, may transfer
8	ownership of the vessel from personal ownership to corporate or
9	other business ownership without terminating the right to moor
10	or operate the vessel under the permit or permits. The existing
11	permit or permits shall be reissued in the name of the
12	transferee corporation or other business entity."

TITLE:

PURPOSE:

To allow a holder of a mooring permit within state small boat harbors to transfer the mooring permit to the new vessel owner under certain terms and conditions.

MEANS:

Amend section 200-10(d), Hawaii Revised Statutes.

JUSTIFICATION:

Currently, no use permit for state small boat harbors issued by the Department is transferrable unless provided for by law. As such, there is no law allowing the transfer of mooring permits that are presently issued by order of seniority from a waitlist. This method of issuance limits the ability of vessel owners to sell their vessels because the potential buyer of the vessel may not already have a place to berth the vessel. The proposed amendment would establish a procedure to allow a mooring permit to be transferred to the next vessel owner by way of sale of the vessel.

Requiring that the vessel be sold at fair market value ensures that the sale price of vessels will not be unreasonably inflated in order to profit from the transfer of a mooring permit.

Impact on the public: There have been several instances where individuals have suffered economic loss from the inability to sell their vessel because of the difficulty for potential purchasers in procuring a mooring permit for the vessel. The proposed amendment would establish a procedure whereby vessels could be more easily bought and sold.
