BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 84, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended 2 by adding a new section to part V to be appropriately designated
- 3 and to read as follows:

- 3 SECTION 5. There is appropriated out of the general
- 4 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 5 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2016-2017 for in-
- 6 person and online ethics training and related activities.
- 7 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the state ethics
- 8 commission for the purposes of this Act.
- 9 SECTION 6. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 10 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 11 SECTION 7. This Act shall take effect upon its approval;
- 12 provided that section 5 of this Act shall take effect on July 1,
- **13** 2016.
