A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE RELEASE OF CERTAIN MISDEMEANANTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 353, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by adding two new sections to be appropriately 3 designated and to read as follows: 4 "§353-A Release of pretrial and sentenced misdemeanants to prevent overcrowding. (a) Notwithstanding chapter 804 and any 5 other law to the contrary and except as provided in subsection 6 7 (b), the director may order the release of a pretrial or 8 sentenced misdemeanant on recognizance to prevent overcrowding 9 when a community correctional center has reached capacity, as 10 determined by the director. The director shall consider the 11 circumstances and nature of the pretrial or sentenced 12 misdemeanant's charge or offense prior to ordering a release 13 pursuant to this section. The director's order shall supersede and have the same force and effect as an order entered by a 14 court pursuant to chapter 804. For purposes of this section, 15 16 "sentenced misdemeanant" shall mean a misdemeanant or petty 17 misdemeanant sentenced pursuant to section 706-663.
