## A BILL FOR AN ACT

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. Section 286-4.1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 3 "(a) There is established within the office of the state 4 director of transportation for administrative purposes a medical 5 advisory board consisting of not fewer than five physicians 6 licensed to practice in the State. The members of the board shall be appointed by the governor as provided in section 26-34, 7 8 except as otherwise provided by this section. The board shall 9 consist of [one psychiatrist, one neurologist, one orthopedic 10 surgeon, one ophthalmologist or optometrist, and one specialist in cardiovascular disease.] physicians with an interest in one 11 12 or more of the following: 13 (1) Psychiatry; 14 (2) Neurology; 15 (3) Orthopedics; 16 (4) Ophthalmology or optometry; 17 (5) Endocrinology; 18 (6)

- 1 (7) Addiction medicine.
- 2 The members of the board shall serve without compensation but
- 3 shall be reimbursed for expenses, including travel expense,
- 4 actually incurred in the performance of their duties under this

- 7 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 8 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
