

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO NON-GENERAL FUNDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	PART I
2	SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to repeal,
3	reclassify, or abolish selected funds.
4	PART II
5	SECTION 2. The purpose of this part is to repeal the
6	Kapolei recreational sports complex special fund as recommended
7	by the auditor in auditor's report 14-01.
8	The legislature finds that the original purpose of the fund
9	no longer exists, as the land originally identified for the
10	Kapolei recreational sports complex was transferred to the
11	University of Hawaii-West Oahu.
12	SECTION 3. Section 109-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
13	amended to read as follows:
14	"§109-3 Stadium special fund. There is created a special
15	fund to be known as the stadium special fund into which funds
16	collected by the authority shall be deposited[; provided that
17	all funds received pursuant to this section shall be kept

- completely separate from the Kapolei recreational sports complex
 special fund. Moneys may not be transferred between the stadium
- 3 special fund and the Kapolei recreational sports complex special
- 4 fund]. The stadium special fund shall be applied, used, and
- 5 disposed of for the payment of:
- (1) The expenses of the operation, maintenance, promotion,
 and management of; and
- 8 (2) All or a portion of the cost of financing any capital9 improvement project for;
- 10 the stadium and related facilities; provided that all services
- 11 required for the stadium and related facilities shall be
- 12 performed by persons hired on contract or otherwise, without
- 13 regard for chapter 76; provided further that the authority shall
- 14 report to the legislature all receipts and expenditures of the
- 15 stadium special fund account twenty days prior to the convening
- 16 of each regular session."
- 17 SECTION 4. Section 109-9, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 18 repealed.
- 19 ["[\$109-9] Kapolei recreational sports complex special
- 20 **fund.** There is created a special fund to be known as the
- 21 Kapolei recreational sports complex special fund into which



1	funds appropriated by the legislature, received pursuant to a
2	management contract under section 109-2(3), or collected by the
3	authority from the operations of the Kapolei recreational sports
4	complex shall be deposited subject to contracts entered into
5	pursuant to section 109-2(3); provided that all funds received
6	pursuant to this section shall be kept completely separate from
7	the stadium special fund. Moneys may not be transferred between
8	the Kapolei recreational sports complex special fund and the
9	stadium special fund. The Kapolei [recreational] sports complex
10	special fund shall be applied, used, and disposed of for the
11	payment of:
12	(1) The expenses of the operation, maintenance, promotion,
13	and management of; and
14	(2) All or a portion of the cost of financing any capital
15	improvement project for;
16	the Kapolei recreational sports complex; provided that all
17	services required for the Kapolei recreational sports complex
18	shall be performed by persons hired on contract or otherwise,
19	without regard for chapter 76; provided further that the
20	authority shall report annually to the legislature all receipts
21	and expenditures of the Kapolei recreational [sports] complex

- 1 special fund account no later than twenty days prior to the
- 2 convening of each regular session."]
- 3 SECTION 5. On July 1, 2016, all unencumbered balances
- 4 remaining in the Kapolei recreational sports complex special
- 5 fund repealed by section 4 of this Act shall lapse to the credit
- 6 of the general fund.
- 7 PART III
- 8 SECTION 6. The purpose of this part is to reclassify the
- 9 prepaid airport use charge fund from a special fund to a trust
- 10 fund as recommended by the auditor in auditor's report 14-05.
- 11 The legislature finds that the fund does not meet the
- 12 criteria of a special fund and should be classified as a trust
- 13 fund because moneys deposited in the fund are the property of
- 14 signatory airlines and may not be used for any purpose other
- 15 than those set forth in the prepaid airport use charge fund
- 16 agreement.
- 17 SECTION 7. The prepaid airport use charge fund, a special
- 18 fund administratively established in 1977, is reclassified as a
- 19 trust fund.
- 20 All balances in the fund shall remain as if no
- 21 reclassification had occurred.



1	PART IV
2	SECTION 8. The purpose of this part is to abolish the
3	photo enforcement revolving fund.
4	The legislature finds that the fund does not meet the
5	criteria of a revolving fund because it is inactive.
6	SECTION 9. The photo enforcement revolving fund is
7	abolished and any unencumbered remaining balances shall be
8	transferred to the general fund.
9	PART V
10	SECTION 10. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
11	and stricken.
12	SECTION 11. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2016.

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Report Title:

Non-general Funds; Repeal; Reclassify; Transfer of Balances

Description:

Repeals the Kapolei recreational sports complex special fund, reclassifies the prepaid airport use charge fund to a trust fund, and abolishes the photo enforcement revolving fund. Transfers the remaining unencumbered balances to the general fund.

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
