A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CHARTER SCHOOLS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 The legislature finds that certain department SECTION 1. 2 of education schools, such as those located in leeward Oahu, are 3 operating at or near-full capacity and struggling with severe 4 overcrowding. Additionally, public school capacity concerns 5 have been raised in connection with the projected construction 6 of residential high-rises in the Kakaako community development 7 district. 8 Section 302D-13, Hawaii Revised Statutes, provides for the 9 creation of new start-up public charter schools. Public charter 10 schools could be a crucial piece of a larger solution to address 11 school overcrowding as public charter schools can often be 12 established and begin operation in less time than it would take 13 to establish and open a new school under the department of 14 education. The state public charter school commission 15 identified the following priority needs for applications in its

(1) New schools that would provide additional school capacity in geographic areas in which existing public

1		schools are already exceeding, have already reached,
2		or are projected to reach or exceed full enrollment
3		capacity; and
4	(2)	New schools that would serve communities in which
5		existing public schools are not performing well
6		academically, as measured by the State's strive HI
7		performance system and other student outcomes, and
8		that present a plan for improving these outcomes.
9	Although the State previously provided start-up grants to	
10	assist public charter schools with their pre-opening costs	
11	before operating funds become available to them, currently, pre	
12	opening charter schools receive no state assistance in meeting	
13	these significant challenges.	
14	The purpose of this Act is to provide funding for start-up	
15	grants to assist one or more new pre-opening charter schools.	
16	SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general	
17	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$200,000 or so much	
18	thereof a	s may be necessary for fiscal year 2016-2017 for start-
19	up grants for pre-opening public charter schools that will meet	
20	the priority needs identified by the state public charter schoo	
21	commissio	on in its request for proposals for new schools. The

- 1 state public charter school commission shall establish grant
- 2 criteria and guidelines for use of grant funds.
- 3 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the state public
- 4 charter school commission for the purposes of this Act.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
