BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. (a) The state procurement office, in
2	conjuncti	on with the department of accounting and general
3	services,	shall conduct a comprehensive analysis and review of

6	(b)	At a minimum, the analysis and review shall include:
7	(1)	The effectiveness and efficiency of the current Hawaii
8		public procurement process;
9	(2)	A cost-benefit analysis of the current Hawaii public
10		procurement process;
11	(3)	A review of issues and concerns raised by businesses
12		and the general public regarding the Hawaii public
13		procurement process, including issues involving delays
14		in the procurement process, as well as delays in
15		payment for the receipt of goods and services;
16	(4)	A review of federal procurement laws, particularly the
17		Federal Acquisition Regulation, and a comparison of

1		the similarities and differences between the nawari
2		public procurement code and federal procurement laws;
3	(5)	An analysis of whether closer alignment of the Hawaii
4		public procurement code to federal procurement laws
5		would be cost beneficial to the State;

7		Hawaii public procurement code to correct
8		inefficiencies, if any;
9	(7)	The length of time and the effort required by the
10		State to implement changes to better align the Hawaii
11		procurement code with federal procurement laws; and
12	(8)	Any costs, including personnel costs, to the State
13		should the Hawaii public procurement code be amended
14		to more closely align with federal procurement laws.
15	(c)	The state procurement office shall submit a report of
16	its findings and recommendations, including any proposed	
17	legislation, to the legislature no later than twenty days prior	
18	to the convening of the regular session of 2017.	
19	SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general	
20	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
