### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AGRICULTURE.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 The legislature finds that agriculture is SECTION 1. 2 important to the economy of the State, provides many jobs for 3 residents, and contributes to the health and well-being of the 4 entire community. 5 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to establish the agriculture grant program within the department of agriculture 6 7 to assist qualified farmers by providing grants for specific 8 agricultural purposes. 9 SECTION 2. Chapter 141, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated

11 and to read as follows:

12 Agriculture grant program; agriculture grant "§141program special fund. (a) There is established within the 13 14 department of agriculture an agriculture grant program that shall assist qualified farmers by providing grants to: 15 16 (1) Expand farm operations;


