

### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AMERICAN SIGN LANGUAGE.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that official recognition
- 2 of American Sign Language would provide many benefits to the
- 3 State and its people, including:
- 4 (1) Allowing deaf children to become more self-confident
- 5 in their identity, gain language fluency at an earlier
- 6 age, and improve their critical-thinking skills;
- 7 (2) Enriching the language development of hearing
- 8 children; and
- 9 (3) Recognizing that American Sign Language is one of the
- 10 most popular foreign languages at institutions of
- higher education in the United States.
- The purpose of this Act is to establish and designate
- 13 American Sign Language as an official foreign language of the
- 14 State.
- 15 SECTION 2. Chapter 5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
- 16 by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to
- 17 read as follows:

- 1 "§5- Official foreign language. American Sign Language
- 2 is established and designated as an official foreign language of
- 3 the State."
