A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO DEATH CERTIFICATES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the sharing of
- 2 information regarding a deceased resident of Hawaii is a
- 3 challenge for government agencies that provide payments,
- 4 programs, and services. The legislature also finds that moneys
- 5 are distributed to deceased individuals and the recovery of
- 6 those moneys is a daunting task, subject to hours of labor.
- 7 The purpose of this Act is to establish a working group to
- 8 develop a reporting system under which government agencies that
- 9 make automatic payments to a recipient are timely notified of
- 10 the recipient's death.
- 11 SECTION 2. (a) There is established the death
- 12 certificates working group, which shall develop a reporting
- 13 system under which government agencies that make automatic
- 14 payments to a recipient are timely notified of the recipient's
- 15 death. Payments shall include payments from programs and
- 16 services such as medicaid, the employees' retirement system, and
- 17 other post-employment benefits.



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- (b) The working group shall be composed of the followingmembers or their designees:
- 3 (1) The director of finance, who shall serve as the 4 chairperson of the working group;
- 5 (2) The executive director of the employees' retirement system;
- 7 (3) The director of health;
- 8 (4) The director of human services;
- 9 (5) The director of taxation;
- 10 (6) The chief election officer;
- 11 (7) The chief justice of the supreme court; and
- 12 (8) The chief medical examiner or coroner for each of the
- four counties.
- 14 The director of finance shall also invite the Honolulu and
- 15 the Kapolei district managers for the Social Security
- 16 Administration to be two additional members of the working
- 17 group.
- 18 (c) The working group shall be administratively placed in
- 19 the department of budget and finance. The director of finance
- 20 shall initiate the organization of and provide staff support for
- 21 the working group.



- 1 (d) Members of the working group shall serve without
- 2 compensation, but shall be reimbursed for necessary expenses
- 3 incurred during the performance of their duties.
- 4 (e) The working group shall submit a report of its
- 5 findings and recommendations, including any proposed
- 6 legislation, to the legislature and governor not later than
- 7 twenty days prior to the convening of the regular session of
- 8 2016.
- 9 (f) The working group shall cease to exist upon the
- 10 adjournment sine die of the regular session of 2016.
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
