A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 291C, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by adding a new section to part V to be appropriately designated and to read as follows: 3 4 "<u>§291C-</u> <u>Slow-moving motor vehicles</u>. Any person driving 5 a motor vehicle on a two-lane highway: 6 (1)Where passing or overtaking another motor vehicle is 7 unsafe or not permitted; 8 (2) At a rate of speed less than the current flow of 9 traffic; and 10 (3) With a line of five or more motor vehicles following 11 immediately behind the driver's motor vehicle;
- 12 shall move off of the highway at the nearest reasonable and safe
- 13 location to allow the trailing motor vehicles to overtake the
- 14 driver's motor vehicle."
- 15 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 16 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 17 begun before its effective date.

SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
