## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 The legislature finds that it is valuable to SECTION 1. 2 support and expand career readiness opportunities for high 3 school students. According to the United States Department of Education, aligning high schools with career readiness programs 4 is the pipeline to strengthening the middle class. For too many 5 6 students, high school is a time of disengagement that fails to put students on a path to college and career success. 7 8 address this issue, many states are adopting career and technical education pathways recommended by the Unites States 9 10 Department of Education to ensure that young people graduate 11 with real world skills and abilities that are aligned with the 12 needs of a global economy. 13 The legislature also finds that searider productions 14 academy, a digital media training program within Waianae high

academy, a digital media training program within Waianae high school, has been recognized by the national education community as a model for twenty-first century classrooms. The program engages students and raises academic expectations by utilizing

- 1 vocational training, collaboration, critical thinking,
- 2 technology skills, and leadership opportunities. This program
- 3 is proof that preparing young adults for success and helping
- 4 them stay engaged and motivated in their academic experience
- 5 requires a different educational experience than a generation
- 6 ago.
- 7 The legislature further finds that many high school
- 8 graduates lack exposure to learning that links their work in
- 9 school to college and careers. This is especially true in the
- 10 fields of science, technology, engineering, and mathematics.
- 11 Moreover, many international competitors offer students a more
- 12 rigorous and relevant education in the middle and high school
- 13 years. To compete with such programs, schools in the United
- 14 States must do more to engage, prepare, and inspire college- and
- 15 career- ready students. In addition, career and technical
- 16 education programs in our country must be better aligned to
- 17 employer and postsecondary needs.
- 18 Finally, the legislature finds that one opportunity for
- 19 Hawaii to connect the education pipeline from high school to
- 20 college is to support an academy of creative media at the
- 21 University of Hawaii, West Oahu campus. Current support within

- 1 the University of Hawaii, the success of searider productions
- 2 academy, recent growth of the University of Hawaii, West Oahu
- 3 campus, and the close proximity of the two locations provide a
- 4 unique opportunity to address college- and career-readiness in
- 5 the State's high school students.
- 6 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to designate fifty
- 7 acres at the University of Hawaii, West Oahu campus, for a
- 8 creative media technology campus that includes a motion picture,
- 9 television, digital media, and post production studio complex
- 10 which will include facilities for creative media development,
- 11 post production, and student housing.
- 12 SECTION 2. The University of Hawaii system shall set aside
- 13 fifty contiguous acres for a creative media technology campus at
- 14 the University of Hawaii, West Oahu campus. The creative media
- 15 technology campus shall include a motion picture, television,
- 16 digital media, and post production studio complex, as well as
- 17 student housing for the campus.
- 18 The University of Hawaii system and University of Hawaii,
- 19 West Oahu campus, shall submit a report to the legislature no
- 20 later than twenty days prior to the convening of the regular

1 session of 2017 detailing the progress of the creative media 2 technology campus. 3 SECTION 3. The following entities shall enter into a 4 memorandum of agreement to design, plan, and develop the 5 creative media technology campus at the University of Hawaii, 6 West Oahu campus: 7 University of Hawaii, West Oahu campus; (1)8 (2) University of Hawaii, academy for creative media; 9 (3) Department of education; 10 (4) Hawaii housing finance and development corporation; 11 (5) State of Hawaii film office; and High technology development corporation. 12 (6) This Act shall take effect upon 13 SECTION 4. approval. 14 INTRODUCED BY:

#### Report Title:

University of Hawaii; West Oahu Campus; Creative Media Technology Campus

### Description:
