8	(1)	The member serves in a position that has been
9		identified for layoff due to the consolidation or
10		abolition of functions, or the privatization of the
11		functions of the position as a result of Act 103,
12		Session Laws of Hawaii 2015; and
13	(2)	The member is otherwise eligible for a service
14		retirement as of the date of application for
15		retirement.
16	(b)	An active member who is eligible under subsection (a)
17	for a retirement benefit incentive for members separated from	

- 1 service shall receive a retirement incentive of one-twelfth of a
- 2 year of additional retirement credit for each year of service
- 3 credit earned as of the date of retirement or separation from
- 4 service pursuant to subsection (a)(1), up to a maximum of three
- 5 years of service credit as of the date of retirement."

- 8 and shall be repealed on June 30, 2017.
