6	temporary	retirement benefit incentive if:
7	(1)	The member serves in a position that has been
8		identified for layoff due to the consolidation or
9		abolition of functions, or the privatization of the
10		functions of the position; and
11	(2)	The member is otherwise eligible for a service
12		retirement as of the date of application for
13		retirement.
14	(b)	An active member who is eligible under subsection (a)
15	for a retirement benefit incentive shall receive a retirement	
16	incentive of one-twelfth of one year of additional retirement	
17	credit for each year of service credit earned as of the date of	
18	retirement or separation from service pursuant to subsection
