(a) Notwithstanding sections 4 329D-2(d), 329D-3, 329D-4, 329D-5, and 329D-7(B) to the 5 contrary, each county in which dispensary licenses are 6 authorized to be issued may apply for a dispensary license; 7 provided that the counties shall be subject to: 8 The dispensary license fee pursuant to section 329D-9 (1) 10 4(c); and The annual renewal fee pursuant to section 329D-4(n). 11 (2) The application for a county applicant shall be 12 (b) submitted to the department and shall include supporting 13 documentation to establish that the county has committed 14 sufficient resources to ensure financial stability and the 15 capacity to comply and follow-through with the applicable 16 requirements of this chapter and the rules of the department. 17
