A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FIREARMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that accurate firearm 2 registration records and the sharing of firearm registration 3 records among the counties is critical to ensure the safety of 4 the community. The purpose of this Act is to authorize the Hawaii criminal 5 6 justice data center to view firearm registration data to 7 facilitate a firearm registration information sharing initiative 8 among the county police departments. 9 Section 134-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is SECTION 2. 10 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows: 11 "(b) Every person who acquires a firearm pursuant to 12 section 134-2 shall register the firearm in the manner 13 prescribed by this section within five days of acquisition. The 14 registration shall be on forms prescribed by the attorney 15 general, which shall be uniform throughout the State, and shall 16 include the following information: name of the manufacturer and 17 importer; model; type of action; caliber or gauge; serial

1 number; and source from which receipt was obtained, including the name and address of the prior registrant. If the firearm 2 3 has no serial number, the permit number shall be entered in the 4 space provided for the serial number, and the permit number 5 shall be engraved upon the receiver portion of the firearm prior 6 to registration. All registration data that would identify the 7 individual registering the firearm by name or address shall be 8 confidential and shall not be disclosed to anyone, except as may 9 be required for processing the registration, database management 10 by the Hawaii criminal justice data center, or as may be required by a law enforcement agency for the lawful performance 11 12 of its duties or as may be required by order of a court." 13 SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that

14 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were 15 begun before its effective date.

16 SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.

17 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
